About the Department

The Department of Library and Information Science (University of Kashmir), established in 1970, is committed to the University's mission of teaching, learning, research and community services. The department, one of the pioneer LIS departments in northern India, imparts knowledge and skills to Information professionals by integrating the LIS curriculum with technological advancements. Our passouts effectively get good job offers from the government and private sector. The department provides an intellectually stimulating environment for productive learning to enhance the capabilities of these outgoing LIS professionals in educational, economic, scientific, business and cultural environments. The department is actively engaged in innovative projects, seminars, workshops, and the development of digital library test beds.

The Department offers a Two-year Integrated Masters Degree in Library and Information Science (MLIS) with an updated curriculum and Syllabus that caters to the varied demands of different types of Job Sectors, including organizations and industries. The department also provides an ample environment for LIS research and currently offers Ph.D. Degree in Library and Information Science. Besides, the teaching faculty and researchers continuously share their research in research publications, including Journal Articles, Book chapters, conference publications and presentations. Library and Information Science (LIS) being an interdisciplinary field imparts theoretical and practical foundations for managing information and knowledge resources and products

through consolidation and repackaging techniques. The discipline equips students with the documentation of records about history, memory, and different fields of knowledge; it also emphasizes producing professionals with information literacy and technical skills essential in supporting managers in different organisational settings. The skill set inculcated among students significantly improves information and knowledge management systems by proper collection development, management, preservation, storage and delivery of information assets thus helping different organisations and social contexts. Here the role of LIS schools becomes more critical in the modern knowledge-based society with more focus on supportive decision-making at different levels. Thus, enabling critical thinking analysis in modern society through I wmanagement practices based on diversity, equity and inclusion. LIS professionals work in different settings, including libraries, archives, museums, galleries, academic institutions, non-profit organisations, corporations and other institutions, besides freelancers for data management and information retrieval.

The library and information science courses, mainly, are focused on tuning in with the growing demands of the job market in terms of skills, competencies and strategies necessary for addressing cross-domain education & research, particularly focussing on openness, including open education facilitating equitable access to quality education for all. These courses generate good rank at the global level and lay emphasis on developing relationships between people based on knowledge sharing among communities. The rich array of LIS course papers allows students to learn concepts and examine *intricacies and issues related to information products & resources in the humanities, social sciences, physical and natural sciences, computational and information sciences*. Students gain experience in exploring the ethical, cultural, and social challenges inherent in *designing and using information technology-based and data-driven solutions*. The LIS courses emphasise the practical design of systems for the betterment of people, organisations, and society.

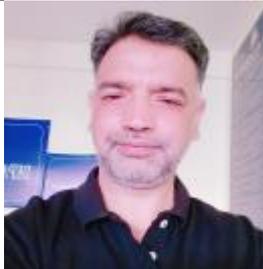

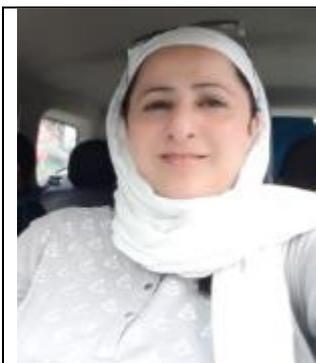
